PACE Committee Approves New Anti-Armenian Report



YEREVAN -- The Committee on Social Affairs of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE) has adopted a second anti-Armenian report within less than a month, which according to the Deputy Foreign Minister of Armenia, Shavarsh Kocharyan solely plays into the hands of the Azerbaijani propaganda machine, and fits into Baku's attempts to flop the Karabakh peace process.

After a report calling on Armenia to withdraw its troops from the "occupied territories," another report was adopted at the PACE Committee's latest session. It is called "Inhabitants of Frontier Regions of Azerbaijan are Deliberately Deprived of Water" referring to Karabakh-located Sarsang Reservoir. The report was prepared by

Bosnian MP Milica Markovic, who already managed to visit Azerbaijan twice without visiting Nagorno Karabakh where he could get acquainted with the situation in the Sarsang Reservoir.

"The draft of the report is only a grist for the mill of Azerbaijan's propaganda machine and is in line with the logistics of Baku's policy of undermining the negotiation process, unceasing efforts aimed at escalating the situation along the border between Armenia and Azerbaijan and on the Line of Contact with Nagorno-Karabakh, shifting the discussions on the issue into other formats and constantly voicing criticism addressed at the [the OSCE Minsk Group] Co-Chairs," stated Kocharyan.

Bridget Brink: The United States Has Invested More Than \$2 Billion into Armenia's Economy Since 1992

YEREVAN (Arka.am) -- The United States has provided more than \$2 billion to Armenia since 1992, Bridget Brink, the U.S. Deputy Assistant Secretary in the Bureau of European and Eurasian Affairs, said Thursday in Yerevan at an annual session of the U.S.-Armenia Intergovernmental Commission for Economic Cooperation.

She said that economic relations with Armenia are very important to the United States and that her country is proud that it makes efforts to help Armenia.

The United States has invested more than \$2 billion into Armenia's economy since 1992, she said, expressing confidence that this support might enhance Armenia's welfare.

Brink stressed that the emphasis in relations between the two countries has already shifted from economic assistance to direct investments.

In this context, she welcomed the Vorotan Cascade Hydro Power Plant sale deal, which has become the biggest investments project of the



United States in Armenia.

Vorotan Cascade Hydro Power Plant CJSC was sold to the United States' Contour Global Hydro Cascade for \$180 million.

The cost price of one KWh hour of the electric power generated by this plant is lowest in Armenia.

Brink expressed hope that her country will make similar large invest-

FM Nalbandian: Nothing Related to Nagorno-Karabakh Can be Settled Without the Consent of its People

YEREVAN -- No question related to the Karabakh conflict settlement can be resolved without the consent of the people of Artsakh, Armenian foreign minister Edward Nalbandian said in an interview with "Aravot" daily in comments on rumors that during his latest visit to Yerevan Russian foreign minister Sergei Lavrov tried to persuade Armenia to hand several regions surrounding the administrative borders of Nagorno-Karabakh back to Azerbaijan.

"I prefer declining comments on reports that have nothing in common with the real state of affairs. Those disseminating such information do not even know what they are talking about.

"At our joint press conference with Russian FM Sergey Lavrov, we addressed the topics we had discussed, including the Nagorno-Karabakh peace process. Russia is one of the OSCE Minsk Group co-chairing countries, and we highly appreciate the efforts Russia and the other co-chairing countries are exerting to find a peaceful

settlement of the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict. We hold about ten meetings with the Russian foreign minister - at both the bilateral level and multilateral level - which is natural in the context of our strategic relations. And the press may disseminate information on each meeting and report issues related to the Nagorno-Karabakh peace process had been discussed. And, I should note they can mostly be right. With few exceptions, the issue is always on our agenda. It is natural.

"Another question is when the press is adding other elements to such discussions, referring to sources 'close to the negotiators.' I would not take it for granted. It is difficult to know what sources they can quote as the negotiations are taking place at a high level and in a narrow format.

"I would advise referring to official information in commenting on such issues. The president of the OSCE Minsk group c-chairing countries made

Armenian Genocide Documents from Vatican Archives Published in 7-Volume Set



ROME -- On November 21, presentation of unique series of seven-volume set of books by Father Georges-Henri Ruyssen was held in the Pontifical Oriental Institute of Santa Maria Maggiore in Rome. The event was organized by the Embassy of Armenia in the Holy See.

Rector of the Pontifical Oriental Institute David Nazar, founder of the Community of Sant'Egidio Andrea Riccardi, president of the Community of Sant'Egidio Marco Impagliazzo, clergymen of Armenian Apostolic and Catholic churches, representatives of public and political sector, members of Armenian community in Italy were among the participants of the event.

The publication presents all the documents on the Armenian Genocide from the period of the Hamidian massacres till the post-Genocide years of

Kemalist rule, which were preserved in the Vatican closed archives, and gives a full picture of all the stages of this crime, from planning to implementation of the genocide.

During his speech Ambassador of Armenia to the Holy See Mikael Minasyan particularly stressed the fact that this seven-volume set is a significant achievement for Genocide studies and is a history which also that of the Turks. "The work by Father Ruyssen helps us to trace back the facts. It helps us to read the past thus learning the lessons for the future."

At the event Ambassador Minasyan handed over to Father Georges-Henri Ruyssen the Order of Honour awarded by the President of Armenia for the development of the Armenian studies and for his significant contribution to dissemination of spiritual values.

More than a Million Viewers Watch 'Conan In Armenia'



HOLLYWOOD—An average of 1.04M viewers caught TBS' unveiling of Conan In Armenia at 11 PM ET Tuesday, 666K of whom fell into the 18-49 age bracket - both about double what Conan's been averaging recently. Another 317K viewers of all ages watched a replay immediately after the premiere, at 12:30 AM ET, 226K of them in the demo, Deadline.com reports.


When TBS unveiled Conan O'Brien's historic trip to Cuba in March, it logged 1.3 million viewers in its 11 PM ET premiere on Wednesday, after which the network immediately ran it again, posting another 510,000 viewers. That crowd grew to 3.7 million viewers who checked out O'Brien becoming the first American late-night host to do a show in Cuba in more than 50 years. Conan in Armenia likewise is expected to grow.

In the video he has all sorts of merrymaking on his trip to the South Caucasus country where in the streets and marketplaces he tries to use some of the spoken Armenian phrases that he has learned from a language instructor back in Los Angeles.

Besides the usual "Barev" (hello) and "Inchpes es" (how are you?) phrases, those include expressions literally translated as "I eat your liver" and "I die on your body", a way Armenians express their sympathy towards close friends and family.

While in Armenia, O'Brien and Movsesian herded sheep and sampled the local alcoholic beverages, and O'Brien took Movsesian to an Armenia matchmaker—all fodder for O'Brien's trademark sardonic humor. O'Brien also appeared in an Armenian soap opera.

Global Terrorism Index: Armenia Ranked Among World's Safest Countries



YEREVAN (Armradio.am) -- 2015 Global Terrorism Index published by the Institute for Economics and Peace rates Armenia as one of the safest countries in the world in terms of potential terrorist threats.

Armenia is ranked 116th among 162 countries, where a lower place means less danger in terms of terrorism.

Armenia's neighbors in the region are placed as follows: Georgia – 71st, Turkey – 27th, Azerbaijan – 93rd and Iran – 39th.

Armenia's partners in the Eurasian Economic Union Russia and Belarus are ranked 23rd and 77th respectively, Kazakhstan is 83rd, Kyrgyzstan is 86th.

The Global Terrorism Index provides a detailed analysis of the changing trends in terrorism across 162

countries over the last 15 years. It investigates the patterns of terrorism by geographic activity, methods of attack, organizations involved and national economic and political contexts.

According to the report, the number of lives lost to terrorism increased by 80% in 2014, reaching the highest level ever recorded at 32,658. This compares to 18,111 in 2013. According to the third edition of the Global Terrorism Index (GTI), out today, this increase represents the largest yearly increase in deaths ever recorded. The report also highlights the dramatic rise in terrorism over time, with deaths increasing by nine-fold since the year 2000.

The report, developed by the Institute for Economics and Peace is based on data from the Global Terrorism Database of START.

Azerbaijan Hands Over Armenian POW to Nagorno-Karabakh

STEPANAKERT -- Azerbaijan has handed over on Wednesday a Karabakh Armenian soldier who was taken prisoner in March after crossing the Armenian-Azerbaijani "line of contact" around Nagorno-Karabakh in still unclear circumstances.

According to the Nagorno-Karabakh State Commission on Prisoners of War, Hostages and Missing Persons, Andranik A Grigoryan, a private of the Defense Army, was repatriated on Wednesday afternoon through the mediation of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC). The hand-over took place at the Line of Contact near the village of Bash Garvand in Aghdam.

During his captivity, the ICRC regularly visited him to assess the con-



ditions in which he was held, the treatment he received and to facilitate contact with his family.

Human Skulls, Bones Found at Istanbul's Former Armenian Cemetery



ISTANBUL--Human skulls and bones were found during ongoing excavations at Taksim Square in central Istanbul, Zaman newspaper reports. The bones reportedly belong to Armenians, since an Armenian cemetery was situated in the area till 1939.

Suleiman the Magnificent ordered construction of the cemetery when his imperial chef Manuk Karaseferian denounced a group of people trying to poison the Sultan. For almost four hundred years the site formed part of the largest Christian burial ground in Constantinople: the Pangaltı Armenian Cemetery.

In 1865, the raging cholera infected not only the general public, but also some courtiers in Istanbul. Armenians were thus banned from burying their dead in the cemetery situated close to the winter palace, an area in Sisli district of Istanbul allocated to the Armenians and Greeks instead.

Sultan Abdulaziz ordered the confiscation of a part of Taksim Armenian cemetery in 1870, with the whole area alienated in 1939.

Governor and Mayor of Istanbul Lutfi Kirdar confirmed the construction of modern-day's Gezi Park and several buildings in 1940.

Armenia Placed Second in European Team Chess Championship

REYKJAVIK -- The national teams of Russia have completely dominated the 2015 European Team Chess Championships, winning the gold medals in both men's and women's tournaments.

In the final round of the men's section Russia tied the match against Hungary to complete the race with 15 points and take the winner's trophy. This is Russia's first gold in ETCC since 2007.

Armenia beat Georgia 3-1 in

the last round, with victories by Levon Aronian and Sergei Movsesian

Two points behind the champions are Armenia, Hungary and France on the shared second place. According to the tie-break, Armenia won the silver medal, while Hungary took the bronze.

The European Team Chess Championships were held from November 12-22, 2015, at the historic Laugardalshöll in Reykjavik, Iceland.

USAID and Smithsonian Partner to Launch "My Armenia" Project



YEREVAN -- The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and the Smithsonian Institution have partnered for an innovative project to support cultural sustainability through cultural tourism in Armenia.

The project was launched on Friday, November 20 during an official ceremony at the Matenadaran Scientific Research Institute of Ancient Manuscripts in Yerevan, which holds one of the world's richest collections of medieval manuscripts and books.

At the event, the U.S. Ambassador to Armenia Richard Mills, Jr., Prime Minister Hovik Abrahamyan, and the Senior Advisor of the Smithsonian's Office of International Relations, Halle Butvin delivered remarks. About 100 people attended the event, including Government members, private sector and the tourism industry representatives.

The four-year project, funded by USAID, aims to enhance and increase cultural heritage tourism in the regions outside Armenia's capital Yerevan, through a unique combination of research, scholarship, support for artisan craft, capacity building, and a strong focus on fresh thinking for tourism development.

"The global tourism market continues to grow and cover new destinations. Armenia's rich cultural heritage, unique cuisine, beautiful natural environment and welcoming people make it a special place," said Ambassador Mills. "The purpose of "My Armenia" project is nothing less than to put Armenia on the map as a world-class tourist destination. We intend to not only contribute to the development of the tourism industry in Armenia, but also ensure that the benefits of that growth are widely distributed across the country by promoting tourism to regions outside of Yerevan, thus enhancing the economic prospects of Armenia's rural communities."

The Smithsonian has a long history of working with communities around the world to support efforts in cultural sustainability, whether pro-

tection cultural heritage threatened by human conflict and natural disaster, or supporting the long-term sustainability of diverse cultural sectors.

Through training, programming, community engagement and documentation, and other methods, Smithsonian curators and project staff from across the Institution will work with partners in Armenia to develop new strategies for sustaining cultural heritage.

This project will support traditional arts, crafts and music in the country and lead to greater benefits for rural communities in Armenia, broader awareness about Armenia in international markets, as well as help protect and enhance Armenia's natural and cultural heritage.

"Tourism can be a driver of economic development by generating employment in hotels and restaurants, as well as increasing business for taxi drivers, those making and selling souvenirs, or those providing goods and services to tourism-related businesses," Ambassador Mills said. "However, to spread the wealth generated by tourism, Armenia needs to develop anchor tourism sites outside of Yerevan and link them together in a tourism circuit that spans the length and breadth of the country. This new project will provide technical assistance to develop such a circuit, which will encourage travelers to travel outside of Yerevan and spend more money in the regions. This is just one of the many ways the U.S. Embassy is partnering with the Armenian people to strengthen the economy of Armenia's rural regions."

The Smithsonian has a long history of working with USAID on international programming to support the conservation of biodiversity, museum workforce capacity building, and emerging cultural institutions. Reflecting a renewed partnership between the two organizations established through a 2013 Memorandum of Understanding, the "My Armenia" project signifies a new, collaborative approach to combine the strengths of the two organizations for greater impact.

Annual Pan-European Phoneton Raises Over 1.3 Million Euros in Donations and Pledges

PARIS -- The annual Pan-European Phoneathon of the Armenian Fund, headed by its French affiliate, has raised over 1.3 million euros in donations and pledges.

The large-scale fundraising campaign, held during November 18-22, mobilized the Armenian communities of France (1,205,569 euros), Germany (76,050 euros) and Switzerland (24,554 euros). Proceeds from the Phoneathon will be used to build community centers in Nagorno Karabakh, expand agricultural-development projects in Armenia's Tavush Region, and provide assistance to Armenian refugees from Syria and Iraq.

The Greek community traditionally joined the Phoneathon with their fundraising held in Greece on November 22. The phoneathon raised around 29,000 euros, which will be used for the construction of a kindergarten in Karin Tak, a village in Nagorno Karabakh's Shushi region.

Following the terrorist attacks in Paris on November 13, the fund's French affiliate stated: "Today France, our country, lies wounded after being assailed at the hands of barbarians. We are in mourning. Many of the children of our own nation, which was sub-



thousands of Armenians who need our urgent assistance. As agreed by Mayor Anne Hidalgo and Patrick Devedjian, the godmother and godfather of our Phoneathon, we will carry the event through, exactly as planned. The words 'You don't scare us,' which are emblazoned on buildings at Paris, fully reflect our stance."

The Phoneathon was preceded by an opening Gala Dinner on November 12, held at the Paris City Hall under the auspices of Mayor Anne Hidalgo.

Armenia Plans to Open Cyber Security Center

YEREVAN. - A center of cyber security is planned to be opened in Armenia in spring 2016. Arsen Taroyan, director of Yerevan Computer Research and Development Institute (YCRDI) told the aforementioned to Armenian News - NEWS.am.

The founder of the center will be YCRDI, which will be backed by a number of state authorities. The center will be located in the territory of "Mars" factory within "Alliance" free economic zone (FEZ). But the center will neither become an FEZ resident nor request tax exemptions. "It will function as a non-profit foundation," Taroyan said.

The center will work in 4 key directions: education and re-qualification, own developments and incubator for beginning developers.

"The developments will relate to the program insurance of the entire security complex of computer system," Taroyan said.

Popular Armenian Actress Varduh Varderesian Passes Away Aged 87

YEREVAN -- Popular Armenian actress Varduh Varderesian passed away on November 24 at the age of 87, according to a report by Armenian Culture Ministry.

Varderesian was born in Bucharest, Romania, in 1928. In 1946 she repatriated to Armenia, where she studied at the studio of Leninakan Dramatic Theater (now Gyumri). She later worked in the same theater. From 1958 onwards, Varderesian was a leading actress at the Sundukian Drama Theatre of Yerevan.

In 1988, Varderesian won the People's Artist of the USSR title, she received the Movses Khorenatsi medal in 1995 and the Mesrop Mashtots order in 2013. In 2002, Varderesian was declared an honorary resident of Yerevan.

Varderesian's filmography in-



cludes parts in more than a dozen and a half movies that made her popular also among broad audiences.

A government commission will be set up for organization of the funeral of the actress.

Armenia's MIKA Placed Second in Junior Eurovision Song Contest

SOFIA -- Malta won the thirteenth edition of the Junior Eurovision Song Contest, which was held at the Arena Armeec hall in the Bulgarian capital of Sofia on Saturday evening.

Destiny Chukunyere performing the song "Not My Soul!" won with 185 points, finishing nine points ahead of the second-placed MIKA from Armenia performing "Love" song. Slovenia

took the third place.

A total of seventeen countries participated in this year's edition of the song contest.

Armenia received maximum 12 points from Georgia, the Netherlands and Belarus.

This is the second victory for Malta in the past three years after the country had won in 2013.

Lark Musical Society Raised \$200,000 at Annual Fundraiser

Event Honored Philanthropists Joe and Joyce Stein

GLENDALE -- The Lark Musical Society raised approximately \$200,000 at its annual fundraising dinner held recently at the Jonathan Club in downtown Los Angeles honoring philanthropists Joe and Joyce Philibosian Stein. Lark is gathering funds to convert a 4,000 sq. ft. building into the Armenian Cultural Museum where Armenian culture and its rich history, heritage, and the arts will be celebrated. The museum will showcase themed lectures and exhibit original Armenian historical documents and treasures that go back hundreds of years. The goal is to raise \$2.5 million to make the museum a reality.

"We were delighted to have honored Joe and Joyce Stein who are true humanitarians, having raised millions of dollars for scholarships for Armenian students and for supporting the arts and music," said Lark Chairman of the Board Andy Torosyan. "We thank all those who attended our annual fundraiser and for contributing to Lark's dream of an Armenian Cultural Museum."

On display at the fundraising event were nine traditional Armenian costumes, each representing a different village. The event also featured one of a very few known inscribed Armenian Orphan Rugs, woven by orphans of the genocide about a century ago. Among the less than 20-recorded Orphan rugs currently in existence in various museums and private collections, only 5 contain inscriptions woven directly into the rug.

The roughly 6-foot-by-4-foot rug is composed of over a half million hand-tied knots and inscribed to someone who aided the Armenian orphans

in Ghazir, Syria after the genocide by the Ottoman Turks in 1915. This rug is currently owned by Mr. Torosyan and will eventually be on permanent display at Lark's Armenian Cultural Museum in Glendale. The rug shall serve as a symbol of survival and a civilized way of life.

Lark Musical Society is a non-profit organization based in Glendale. Lark has actively served the community since 1994 by delivering the highest quality education in classical music to thousands of children, bringing to life hundreds of world class performances, commissioning dozens of world premiere musical works based on Armenian themes and publishing over thirty musical treatises. Lark is one of the most active organizations in the Diaspora working to preserve and enrich the Armenian culture.

To commemorate the centennial of the Armenian Genocide, Lark embarked on a journey to bring 100 events to the community, demonstrating the rebirth of a nation that survived Genocide. ments also in the future and added that her country's government along with Armenian authorities will make every effort to promote American investments in Armenia.

She stressed that as a rule investments are made in the predictable and transparent businesses. It means Armenia should root out corruption and remove other obstacles, she said.

The U.S. official also reminded to

the session participants that the United States simplified visa regime for Armenian citizens in January 2015, and now they can get 10-year entry visas.

Vache Gabrielyan, the Armenian vice-premier and the international economic integration and reforms minister, who spoke at the session as well, said that the activity of the U.S.-Armenia Intergovernmental Commission is one of mechanisms designed for expansion of trade and economic relations between the two countries.
